The addition of Saas-Fee in winter, Loèche-les-Bains, and Pré d'Orvin to the list of MAGIC PASS resorts has helped extend the territory, with particularly exciting offers. NEWS THE MAGIC PASS SOLIDARITY FUND COMPENSATES FOR THE LACK OF SNOW

RESULTS MARCH 1ST 2020

Different regions of the MAGIC PASS territory have seen mixed results this winter season. Visitor records have been broken in the south, whereas in the north, conditions have been challenging. It's a disparity that the cooperative plans to balance by using its solidarity fund for the first time. The Magic Mountains Cooperation model is taking on a new dimension: In addition to the attractiveness of the product for pass holders, support for resorts in difficulty caused by extenuating weather conditions are assured.

This winter has been unusual, setting records in some areas with challenging conditions in others. Pierre Besson, President of Magic Mountains Cooperation, explains: "The key to ensuring visitor numbers in the resorts is having sufficient snow cover and bright sunshine at the right times. That was the case during the Christmas holidays, weekends in January, and the first half of the winter vacation period. Records were broken in southern Chablais and the Rhône Valley, while in the north conditions were extremely marginal."

More than CHF 800,000 distributed to mid and low-altitude resorts

Thanks to an increase in the number of pass holders and ski days, the revenues generated from the beginning of winter until 1 March 2020 surpassed 100 million, with 47 million generated by Magic Pass. This financial result has made it possible to distribute considerable sums to partner resorts before the start of the winter season by using the solidarity fund for the first time to add more than 800,000 CHF to the basic amout. This assistance has allowed resorts located in the Riviera region, the canton of Fribourg, and the Jura Arc to continue offering lift services and guarantee mountain access. It is important to note that clients of these resorts, who are MAGIC PASS holders, were able to enjoy quality snow cover at other partner rsorts above 1500 meters during the entire season.

New MAGIC PASS options

The new MAGIC PASS 2020/2021 is currently on sale for CHF 399 for adults and CHF 269 for children. In addition to the basic offer of access to more than 30 resorts in summer and winter, La Robella Val-de-Travers, Saas-Fee and Saas-Almagell in summer (skiing not included) now extend the territory. The newest fantastic offer for 2020/2021 is a Pools option that allows unlimited, year-round access to mountain pools and thermal baths for CHF 249.




Skier-days until March 1st 2020





Turnover until March 1st 2020




