MAGIC PASS: A 5TH YEAR OF SUCCESS AND NEW HORIZONS

Today, the Magic Mountains Cooperation is presenting the record results of its fifth season in Lausanne. Magic Pass has provided 141,000 people with unlimited access to the mountains in both summer and winter. New for the 2022-23 season, the pass will now include 13 new resorts and is expanding into France, the Bernese Oberland and Upper Valais, with no increase in price. The Magic Pass is on sale from midday today.

For the fifth consecutive season, the Magic Mountains Cooperation is delighted to present the record-breaking figures for its flagship product, Magic Pass. In 2021–22, 141,000 mountain enthusiasts benefited from this unique offer in Switzerland – an increase of 27.6% compared to the previous year. From 1st November 2021 to 10 March 2022, the Magic Pass was used to access 1.53 million ski and leisure days. People accessing the ski slopes with the Magic Pass now account for more than 50% of visits to the partner resorts. With travel restrictions still affecting the tourism sector, this domestic offer has been popular throughout the year: 60% of Magic Pass holders used their pass at least once during the summer of 2021. People who are passionate about the mountains are now forming a real community around this inspiring brand, which is recognised by people of all ages.

2022-23: NEW HORIZONS TO EXPLORE FOR THE SAME PRICE

Over the past five years, the Magic Mountains Cooperation has been expanding its partnerships to include ever more operators in the tourism and leisure sectors. This has helped Magic Pass world to keep growing and evolving substantially. In its sixth year, the Magic Pass initiative will continue to develop, building on the expansion that began last year. Now, for the first time, the area covered by the pass will extend into neighbouring France by including the resort of Métabief in the Arc Jurassien. In Switzerland, no less than 11 resorts are joining Magic Pass in the Bernese Oberland and in Upper Valais. These are: Aeschiallmend, Axalp, Beatenberg, Eriz, Faltschen, Habkern, Heimenschwand, Jaunpass, Niederhorn, Rossberg and Rosswald. In addition, from now on, Glacier 3000 will be included as one of the winter partner resorts that are permanently included in Magic Pass at no extra charge. In total, 13 new partner ski resorts are joining the Magic Pass adventure. All of this means that for CHF 399 (CHF 269 for children), Magic Pass now grants unlimited access to a total of 52 ski resorts and 23 summer destinations – an unparalleled offer.
